

## Fellowship and Honorary Fellowship Guidelines and Nomination Form

Thank you for your interest in submitting a nomination for one the above awards. Please complete this Nomination Form, as thoroughly as possibly, giving supporting evidence where requested. The two categories are:

- **Fellowships** - awarded to Registered members (RSHoms)
- **Honorary Fellowships** – awarded to those who have significantly contributed to the development of the profession of homeopathy who are not necessarily homeopaths and this category carries the designation FSHom (Honorary).

You should be able to demonstrate on your nominee's behalf:

- Innovative work which has been undertaken either in research (evidenced by publication) or in the introduction of a new methodology, which has had a positive impact on homeopathy teaching and practice.
- An outstanding contribution over a substantial period of time to the practice, promotion or teaching of homeopathy, publicly raising the profile of homeopathy and/or significantly contributing to the development of the profession.

A registered member should second your nomination and we would ask that you both respect confidentiality around this application. Nominations may only be made and seconded by RSHoms. An individual member may not nominate and/or second more than 2 nominations in a 2 year period.

Please send your nomination in writing to Clare Foley at the Northampton office by the **1st October** of each year for consideration by the Society. The Board's decision is final in relation to awards.

Successful nominees will be contacted to inform them that they have been nominated and to confirm their acceptance. Terms and conditions of acceptance must be signed and returned 6 weeks before the Annual General Meeting.

A formal presentation of the award will be at the Society's Annual General Meeting.
