

What do homeopathy students learn?

Education in Homeopathy addresses 3 broad areas:

- the essential knowledge, skills and understanding of the discipline

e.g. history and philosophy of homeopathy; concepts of holism; relating theory to practice; the remedies used; different approaches; health sciences; health and social care systems; clinical skills of observation, information gathering, case analysis and review

- personal and professional development required for practice

e.g. use of critical self-reflection and supervision; scope of practice and bounds of competence; problem-solving and planning; patient-centred care; practice management skills

- relationship with the profession as a whole

e.g. communication and professional relationships; commitment to ethical principles; ongoing professional development; context of practice; awareness of and involvement with research and scholarly activity
