

## Indicative Sanctions

1. All restrictions placed on a members registration (except those relating to a members own health) are published on the Society website.
2. The intention of these sanctions is not to be punitive but to protect patients and the wider public interest. However, they may have a punitive effect.
3. The period the indicative sanctions will remain next to members names on the register will depend on the sanction they received:
  - a) Formal Warning – This will not appear on the website as there are no conditions to fulfill and it is only a warning.
  - b) Conditions of Practice Order – This will no longer appear once the conditions have been fulfilled.
    - i) If a member resigns from the Society without completing the order the indication will remain on the website for 2 years and, if after this time they have still not fulfilled the order, there will be an automatic termination as in section 3.d.
    - ii) If the Panel decides to terminate the registrants membership due to non-compliance the indication will appear as in section 3.d.
  - c) Suspension – This will be removed once the term of suspension has ended.
  - d) Termination – this indication will appear for a period not less than 5 years, with a permanent record maintained at the office.
4. Publication of sanctions: indicative sanctions will be removed once fulfilled, however in the case of termination of registration the register entry and annotation will remain on the website until such time the member successfully regains registration, having fulfilled conditions or any other requirements set by the Adjudication Panel.
